Table signage – Do not touch signs can be provided with advance notice.

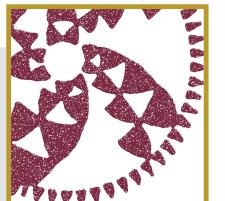
Basic electrical hook-up – One (1) electrical cord will be provided to outlet.

Criteria:

Vendors must be CIBA Members

Vendors Booths will be assigned and paid in advance ONLY

Merchandise will be of a traditional Native American nature

Vendor will be responsible for all his/her equipment

It is the vendor's responsibility to ensure their work is displayed in a manner that protects his or her artwork and the public from harm however; the casino & hotel and CIBA accepts no liability for damage or loss of artwork.

Vendor's work must be their original work and in traditional Native American in nature.

Vendor must comply with current state, national and international laws and regulations with regard to the use of endangered species materials in their works. Use of such materials should be disclosed, in writing.

Stabilized turquoise, man-made or synthetic stones or materials must be disclosed to the consumer.

All merchandise and sales must adhere to the Public Law 101-644, the Indian Arts and Crafts Act of 1990.

CIBA Contract Agreement:

The Vendor (listed above) agrees to hold harmless the Morongo Casino Resort and Spa/Cultural Community Center, its officers, directors, employees, partners, associates, affiliates, joint ventures, agents, consultants and representatives from and against any and all losses, claims, damages, actions, causes of action, costs and expenses that the Vendors may sustain, incur, suffer or be put to at any time either before, during or after the expiration or termination of the Agreement, where the same or any of them are based upon, arise out of or occur, directly or indirectly, by reason of any act or omission of the Vendor or any agent, or employee of the Vendor pursuant to this Agreement, excepting liability arising out of the independent negligent acts of the Morongo Casino Resort and Spa/Cultural Community Center

The Vendor shall be responsible for obtaining any and all insurance necessary for the Vendor, the artwork, and any employees as deemed necessary by the Vendor. VENDOR agrees to abide to all applicable laws as they relate to health and safety codes.

Vendors must be present and remain on-site throughout the Gathering as checked on the vendor application.

Vendor agrees to document and manage all sales transactions for their work, and shall be responsible for the collection, accounting and reporting of all sales tax to the State of California.

This Instrument contains the entire Agreement of the parties relating to the CIBA Gathering and the parties have made no other agreements, representations or warranties relating to the Gathering which are not set forth hereof. No waiver or modification of this Agreement will be valid unless made in writing and signed by both parties.

CIBA POLICY: Vendor acknowledges and accepts CIBA'S "NO ALCOHOL, NO DRUGS" Policy.

I acknowledge that I have read and agree to all the guidelines and terms of the Agreement between the CIBA, the Morongo Casino Resort and Spa/Cultural Community Center, and the Vendor for the 2024 gathering. CIBA and Morongo Casino Resort and Spa/Cultural Community Center, Further, I release and hold harmless the Morongo Casino and Resort and Spa/Cultural Community Building, and all others, as indicated in Term #1 of this Agreement, from any liability whatsoever.
